With only 12 games played between three teams (wonderful English weather), the season never really got off the ground. Still, KCC managed to hold some well supported fundraising events, including a Race Night and Kilvestock 2012 and of course the Kilve Vs Eastquantoxhead match which fell on the Queens Diamond Jubilee weekend which was well supported and it was so nice to see so many familiar faces at the Beach Ground.

We were very well supported again when it came to our Lloyds TSB Community fund grant, which was based primarily on local support and the support of the public who attended sports events up and down the country. People were asked to register their votes online or by text. We were shocked to hear of the result when we were contacted by Lloyds to say we had been successful and also that we had received the most votes out of everyone registered in Somerset. The £5000 awarded has gone towards youth cricket.
